WHY?

- The idea behind this model emerged at our recent presidents' retreat. We hope by setting up an accreditation process TCU is proactive in combatting the temptation to regress to the mean and that our organizations are motivated to continually improve. We also believe this model creates further transparency when it comes to chapter performance and expectations.

CREATION OF QUESTIONS

- Throughout the Spring 2018 semester FSL students were given multiple opportunities to help create questions, point values, and provide input about the implementation of this program. Council Advisors have also provided regular updates to their respective councils about our transition to this model.

USE OF THE RESULTS

- The use of the results of the evaluation will be used to define each organization's level of accreditation. The organization will be able to use this information to set goals for improvement and identify areas in which they may be struggling, as well as recognize and reward organizations that are excelling and being role models in our community. An organization's score will not be published and will only be made known to the members of that specific organization.

USE OF THE RESULTS

- The organizations will be recognized for their achievements at the Greek Awards Ceremony to be held in April each year. Please note that more than one sorority or fraternity may receive recognition.
- Substantial awards will be given to organizations that score in the 100%-80% passing score.

RECOGNITION

- **Gold Chapter of Distinction** 100+%
- **Gold Chapter** 95%-100%
- **Silver Chapter** 88%-94%
- **Bronze Chapter** 80%-87%
- If a chapter obtains Gold Chapter or higher, your chapter will then put together a video presentation that we will submit to the Chancellor. After reviewing the videos, he will selection the Chancellor Chapter of the Year Award.
