New Member Educator and his committee will complete additional training from headquarters on their roles and responsibilities. Chapter officers will attend all upcoming TCU trainings and 2025 officers (to be elected) will be educated on this incident and related outcomes. Covering of cameras is strictly prohibited and chapter members were educated on that expectation.
