### **Spring 2021 Chapter Room Use Guidelines**

Due to on-going concerns related to the COVID-19 pandemic, Fraternity and Sorority Life has developed the following guidelines to assist chapters in their facilitation of in-person events and activities, such as New Member Education, Executive Council meetings, Sisterhood/Brotherhood events, small committee meetings, ritual, etc.. Non-resident swipe access will continue to be disabled.

1. Events must have a responsible host such as the Chapter President, New Member Educator, or other appropriate officer.
2. Events must be created in *Engage* per TCU Student Organizations COVID-19 Guidelines. Events will then be reviewed by Hall Staff.
3. *Engage* must be used to track attendance.
4. Maximum Chapter Room capacity is set at 25 people for the women's facilities and 20 for the men.
5. Physical Distancing must be adhered to at all times. Individuals should be no closer than 6 feet from one another. **If it is not possible to maintain physical distancing with the maximum room capacity, distancing is the policy that must be followed.**
6. Face Coverings must be worn at all times, even with physical distancing measures.
7. All surfaces should be sanitized prior to and after use with provided sanitizing wipes.
8. No singing or physical contact.
9. Proper hand hygiene should be practiced.
